INTRODUCTION:

Our Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi has coined a new slogan "Start-up India, Stand up India" during his Independence Day speech.

"We have to give the youth opportunities to grow and be industrialists and entrepreneurs. We want a start-up network to be established in India." Sh. Modi said

"We will also look to finance those start-ups better that will pledge to provide employment to greater number of people." He added.

The Prime Minister said his government was looking at systems for enabling start-ups. "We must be number one in start-ups – "start-up India and stand up India". We will have 1.25 lakh start-ups, each giving employment to two-three people," he said. In addition to the systems to facilitate startups, Modi said that loans would also be given to help people in their startups. Being a startup it is motivating and will provide better opportunities. It will certainly give positive wave to startups. To begin with Union Budget 2018, 3 lakhs crore has been allocated for MUDRA which is signed of positive impact for entrepreneurship linking with banking system.

India is witnessing a rapidly growing entrepreneurial culture especially in the technology venture room, which promises well not just for the economic growth, but also for meaningful deployment of trained manpower, creation of jobs, ushering in new technologies, products and services and Intellectual Property management.

The National Institute of Technology, Arunachal Pradesh (sponsored by the MHRD, Govt. of India) is one of 31 NITs established by the NITSER Act, 2009. The temporary campus is located in Yupia which is 3 kilometer from Naharlagun/Itanagar Railway station. The Naharlagun/Itanagar Railway station

is the nearest railway station while the nearest airport is Lilabari Airport, 60 kilometers from NIT Arunachal Pradesh and 332 km from Guwahati Airport. ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Management and Humanities was established as a full-fledged department in the year of 2014. Before that. Humanities had been established with the Department of Basic Sciences and Humanities right from the inception of the Institute in 2010. During 2014, Humanities was separated and merged with Management. The Department offers M.Tech programme on Appropriate Technology and Entrepreneurship (ATE) with the intake of 30 students every year before. This course was first time in India, taught in collaboration with National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRD&PR). Hyderabad and is designed to help students to become entrepreneurs, so that they can create jobs rather than they run after jobs. The Department also provides Online MBA programme (first time in India among all NITs) for 2.5 years from the academic year 2014-2015 before. ICT based classes are being conducted for the Online MBA programme. The Department is also offering Ph.D. programme.
