Amendment: Non-involvement of a Second External Expert for JRF to SRF conversion and for State-of-Art Seminar through RAC

Agenda Item 2: Non-involvement of a Second External Expert for JRF to SRF conversion through RAC

Decision: The Committee discussed the requirement of a second external expert during the conversion of Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) to Senior Research Fellowship (SRF). It was unanimously decided that ***no external expert*** is required for this process. The conversion from JRF to SRF shall be carried out through the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) in accordance with the decision taken under Agenda Item No. 55.26 of the 55th Senate meeting.

For Agenda Item 2: Approved.

Agenda Item 3: Non-involvement of a Second External Expert (if any) for State-of-Art Seminar through RAC

Decision: The Committee considered the involvement of a second external expert for the State-of-the-Art Seminar. It was resolved that no additional external expert is required for this purpose. The State-of-the-Art Seminar shall be conducted through the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) alone, as it already includes an expert member. Alternatively (***after abolition of RAC***), it may be conducted through the DRC with the inclusion of one member—preferably possessing relevant specialization—from another department of NIT Arunachal Pradesh.

For Agenda Item 3: From session Jan-June, 2026, RAC will be abolished and SoA will conducted through the DRC with the inclusion of one member—preferably possessing relevant specialization—from another department of NIT Arunachal Pradesh
